Special Topics - Experiential Youth Leadership • CYCA 2500 (3 credit course)

This course incorporates the principles and applications of experiential education into working with client groups who can benefit from the direct experience and authenticity of challenge activities designed to foster problem solving abilities, increased self esteem and greater social competence.

Students will be introduced to both the principles and practise of experiential learning both in the classroom and at EDUCO adventure school in 100 Mile House, learn about themselves and others in a unique and compelling way and develop skills to foster growth and personal development in the individuals they work with in their practise.

Fee: \$1000 (includes tuition and accommodation & meals for the Educo portion of the course)

Dates: We are looking at offering a section of the course in spring 2012 . The Educo portion of the course would be offered for a five day block in May. The rest of the course would be delivered through distance learning seminars.
